Our parish / high school currently offers inclusive Catholic education, making it possible for students of all abilities to attend our parish school. With support from the FIRE Foundation, students with special needs are educated alongside their siblings and peers. K-8 students receive support from a special education teacher/coordinator, classroom teacher and paraprofessionals. High school students also benefit from support provided by peer mentors.

Annual grants from the FIRE Foundation partially support staff salaries and provide professional development, learning resources and technology. It would be very difficult to offer an inclusive learning environment and meet the special learning needs of students without financial support from FIRE and the commitment of our parish community.

All parents of students who receive support services; group support within the classroom, resource room support and/or partial, shared or full-time assistance from para-professionals, are expected to be *ACTIVE* participants in Friends of FIRE (FOF).

Involvement of parents is essential for our school to receive FIRE funding. Parents and families, through FOF, play a vital role at FIRE partner schools by:

- Sharing information with our school community about the benefits of inclusive education for ALL students.
- Engaging school families in FIRE fundraising initiatives and events.

- Attending Friends of FIRE meetings and occasional education sessions.
