Nearly 20 years ago, our founders created a brilliant acronym—FIRE (Foundation for Inclusive Religious Education). In an effort to leverage what's familiar (FIRE) and to underscore our role as fund raisers and advocates for inclusive education, we have rebranded as The FIRE Foundation and added a tagline: Igniting Inclusive Catholic Education. We're excited about our new "look" and confident our brand will carry us forward for many years to come.

>> With assistance from Concera Media, the Foundation launched a refreshed website at firefoundation.org. New content is continually being added to this vital communications link. We invite you to pay us a visit! You can make secure online donations, watch the newest FIRE video, get information on inclusive education, register for upcoming events and more.

>> We're forging new friendships! FIRE is the grateful recipient of a three-year, \$300,000 grant from Loretto Charities, a foundation committed to building stronger families and encouraging spiritual growth. We're blessed to partner with the Hunt family. This gift enabled FIRE to augment 2014-15 grant awards. >> With grant support from the Diocese Life & Justice Office, the FIRE Foundation is partnering with the Diocese School Office to present a professional development day—Responding to the Needs of All Learners—in May 2015 for all Diocesan educators. It is our hope that attendees will learn valuable teaching strategies and become inspired to expand inclusive education efforts.

>> A committee of Board members is exploring opportunities to share the FIRE Foundation model of inclusive Catholic education with parents and educators across the country. During the past year, FIRE fielded more than 30 inquiries from New York to California to Florida and Arizona (and many points in between!) These accomplishments wouldn't be possible without your support. We are blessed so abundantly and we're grateful beyond measure. 
Our Mission

Our mission is to provide children with special needs the opportunity for an inclusive Catholic education in their home parish schools.

Our Story

The FIRE Foundation (aka: Foundation for Inclusive Religious Education) was founded in 1996 by a group of parents who shared a common dream—for their children with special needs to attend their parish schools with siblings and friends. Since that time, through the efforts of parents, dedicated board of directors, exceptional educators and community members who embrace inclusive Catholic education, nearly \$2.5 million dollars have been raised and countless lives have been impacted in a powerful and positive way. FIRE offers financial grants for qualifying schools within the Catholic Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph. These grants assist with the cost of special education teachers, para-professionals and resources, enabling schools to educate children with special needs alongside their peers. The FIRE Foundation raises money and raises awareness and advocates for inclusion of ALL God's children in Catholic schools. We believe that inclusion enhances the education of all children, regardless of ability, by teaching acceptance, compassion and the value of every child of God. Children grow up knowing and appreciating each other's unique gifts.
