Taking our Mission to Heart: 2022 Accomplishments

Revenue continued to grow, making it possible for FIRE to **invest over \$764,000** in inclusive Catholic education. Support included grants for academic support, professional development for educators, student and teacher scholarships as well as speech/language and occupational therapy services. In total, students at 14 partner schools benefited from FIRE support.

FIRE Board and staff engaged in an extensive strategic planning process utilizing input from a range of stakeholders including parents, educators, volunteers and donors. The final plan (approved in January 2023) will guide FIRE's financial, geographic and program growth during the next three to five years.

FIRE expanded delivery of Speech-Language and Occupational Therapy services to seven partner schools. Further expansion is planned for the 2022-23 school year. The Therapy Program, made possible through a partnership with Speech and Language Solutions, has received highly favorable response from partner school communities. Therapy services are customized to meet the unique needs of classes and students.

FIRE continued to work with individuals and groups across the country, sharing our model of inclusion support and advocacy. FIRE partners with eight affiliates:


